For Reflection & Application:

Steps to take this week:

1. Establish a sustainable plan for how you are going to abide in the truth of God's word. (Bob's example: First thing in the morning every week day I'm going to read one installment from the *Wayfinding Bible*, one installment from a devotional book called *Jesus Today*, and one Psalm.) 2. As you read the Bible, pray for God to show you what is true, and for God would use the truth to set you free. For example, here's a passage that you can use as a prayer:

Psalm 119:

33 Teach me, O LORD, the way of your statutes; and I will keep it to the end.

34 Give me understanding, that I may keep your law and observe it with my whole heart.

35 Lead me in the path of your commandments, for I delight in it.

36 Incline my heart to your testimonies, and not to selfish gain!

37 Turn my eyes from looking at worthless things; and give me life in your ways.

38 Confirm to your servant your promise, that you may be feared.

3. As you read the Bible, ask these questions. What is true about God (who he is and what he does)? What is true about me (who I am and what I do)? How should I respond to this truth? Jot down the answers that stand out to you.
