John 10:19 There was again a division among the Jews because of these words. 20 Many of them said, "He has a demon, and is insane; why listen to him?" 21 Others said. "These are not the words of one who is oppressed by a demon. Can a demon open the eyes of the blind?" 22 At that time the Feast of Dedication took place at Jerusalem. It was winter. 23 and Jesus was walking in the temple, in the colonnade of Solomon. 24 So the Jews gathered around him and said to him, "How long will you keep us in suspense? If you are the Christ, tell us plainly." 25 Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in my Father's name bear witness about me, 26 but you do not believe because you are not among my sheep. 27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. 28 I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. 30 I and the Father are one." ESV

For Reflection & Application:

Monday:

If you are a believer in Jesus, to what extent have you experienced assurance or doubts concerning your eternal salvation? What factors have contributed to your assurance or doubts?

Tuesday:

Read John 10:28. If you are a believer in Jesus, personalize this by substituting the pronouns "them" and "they" with "you." How does this make you feel? What, if any, response to God does this encourage?

Wednesday:

Read John 10:29-30. Why do you think Jesus adds his heavenly Father to the promise?

Thursday:

Reread John 10:28. What does this suggest concerning those who do not believe and are not the Lord's sheep? What does this suggest about those claim that we can rest assured that all roads lead to heaven?

Friday:

Reread John 10:28-30. What effect does this promise have on your motivation to obey Jesus?
