For Reflection & Application:

Monday:

Read Leviticus 19:18; Matthew 22:39; John 13:34. What is "new" about Jesus's command to love in John 13:34? How does this apply to you?

Tuesday:

Read Galatians 6:10. Why do you think the Lord wants us to do good "especially to those who are of the household of faith?"

Wednesday:

Scripture presents a number of mutuality or "one another" commands that all come under the umbrella of loving one another. For example, read Romans 15:7; Ephesians 4:2; 5:21; Colossians 3:12-13, 16; James 5:13-16; Galatians 5:13-14; 6:2; 1 Thessalonians 5:11; 2 Corinthians 1:3-4; Hebrews 10:24-25. Pick one and apply to your live today.

Thursday:

Read John 13:35. What is the connection between loving one another within the church and evangelism? Why is this important?

Friday:

Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-3. How does this relate to John 13:34-35? Specifically, what can you do today to love someone in your church family?
