For Reflection & Application:

Monday:

Read John 6:38. According to this verse, who sent Jesus from heaven to earth? In his life on earth, did Jesus pursue his own agenda? Why is this significant for those who want to follow Jesus?

Tuesday:

Read John 6:40. According to this verse, what specifically was Jesus sent to do? What was his mission on earth?

Wednesday:

Read John 10:10. Jesus alludes to two dimensions of eternal life in this verse. What are they and how are they different? How does one experience each one? Why is it important to distinguish them?

Thursday:

Read John 20:21. In this verse, who is Jesus sending? Does this verse apply to believers today? Why or why not? According to this verse, what is the purpose of Jesus sending his disciples? How do you know?

Friday:

How important would you say it is to bring the life of Jesus to other people? Is there anything more important? How can you bring life?
