Big Idea:

For Reflection & Application:

MONDAY:

Read Genesis 22:1-3. Think of a time when you've taken a leap of faith. Did you feel supported, like someone would be there for you in that moment? How does this relate to Abraham's story and simply following God's command to walk in faith? Why was Abraham so willing?

TUESDAY:

Read Genesis 22:7-8. Have you ever experienced wonderings of speculation when God leads you to walk in faith? What can we learn from Isaac's 'going along' of this whole thing?

WEDNESDAY

Read Genesis 1:10-13. How does your relationship with Jesus relate to this part of the story? In what ways can you see Christ in this and how this story parallels that of Jesus?

THURSDAY

Take a moment in reflection and think of how God has had your back before. How can you walk in faith today? Do you believe others around you can see the evidence of Christ in your life?

FRIDAY

Read Romans 8:31-32. How does your daily life relate to these verses? Do you live, sometimes, questioning God's goodness? What are some ways you can trust more like Abraham?
