For Reflection & Application:

Monday:

 Read John 1:1-5. Who or what is the Word? From this text alone, what evidence do you see for your conclusion?

Tuesday:

• From John 1:1-5, what is the relationship between God and the Word? How can be that the Word was with God and also was God?

Wednesday:

• Read John 1:1 and compare with Genesis 1:1. How does Genesis 1:1 shed light on John 1:1, particularly in establishing the identity of the Word?

Thursday:

• In John 1:1-5, the original Greek term for "word" is *logos*, which describes a kind of self-expression or self-revelation. Why is this significant?

Friday:

• If the Word is indeed Jesus, and Jesus is indeed God, the source of life and light, what difference does that make in your life?
